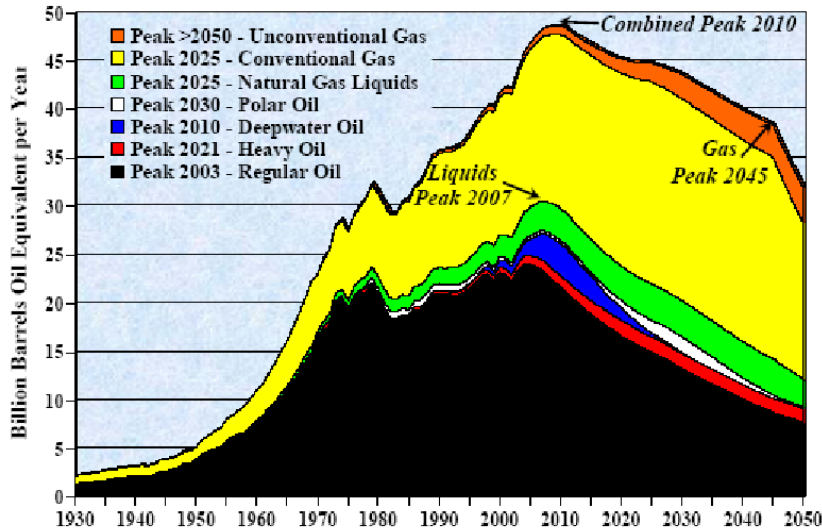
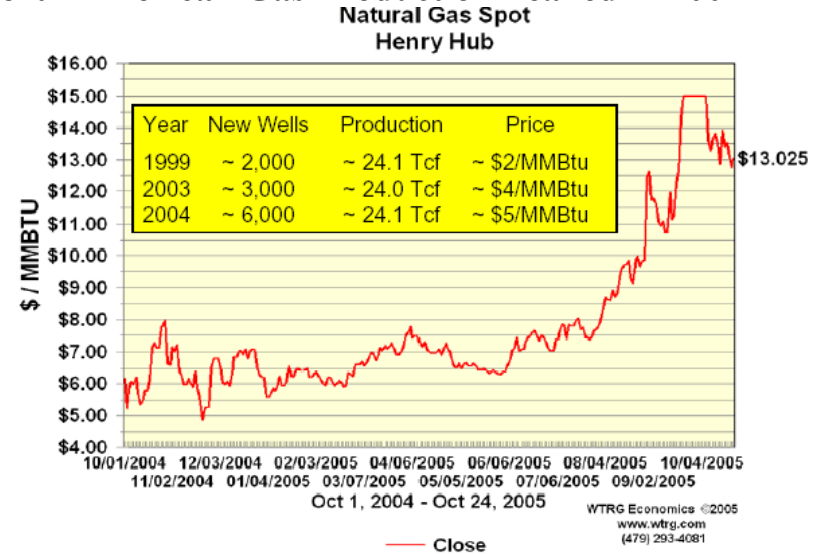

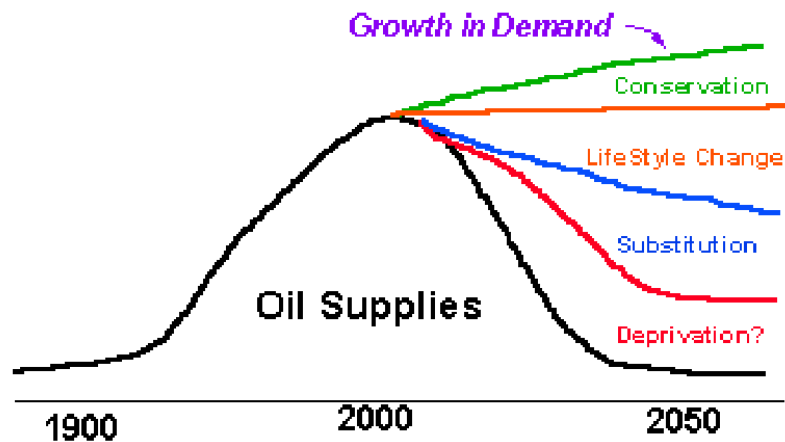
Peak Energy by Type (World Wide)
